Realino has concern toward street children. Street children are one of the most vulnerable groups of urban poor. They face difficulties while living in the streets, and they also develop their own ways to overcome such difficulties. They become street children because of many condition. That conditions are: poverty that make them work to help their parent, they came from homeless family that also live in the street, thrown-away children are more likely to come from single-parent or broken homes.

Street children face difficulties in providing themselves with good sources of food, clean drinking water, health care services, toilets and bath facilities, and adequate shelter. Street children are subject to dangerous and illegal activities such as drug, crime, theft and gang activities. Many of them undertake economic activities such as parking, car washing, vendors, beggar, street performer, etc. Street Children are obviously not educated. Because of that, they don't have the same opportunities as other children.

In Yogyakarta, Indonesia, there are more than 1000 street children who do not get their rights as children. They do not have opportunities to grow fully as children. Based on this condition, we want to give opportunity to the street children to improve their life with the awareness that they have various potentials to develop. They are not criminals, but they need opportunity to grow. We believe that they want to live better and don't want to live in the street. We plan to make skills training for them. We plan to make workshop for the girls and the boys so that they can grow fully.

To realize our plan, we need support. We can't do it by ourselves because of our limitation. Realino asking for help to the board of the SKPI to support us by give us funds to realize ours project. We will manage the funds well as we aim and report transparently.

## **II. Project**

### **1. Organization**

Realino Foundation has two projects. First, distribution of scholarship for the poor children. **Second, empowerment project for the poor, for example: street children, homeless, etc. This proposal is directed toward empowerment programs for street children.**

The aim of the main project is: empowering street children. All children have their rights to grow up fully but the street children can't grow up fully because of the many condition. That conditions are: poverty that make them work to help their parent, they came from homeless family that also live in the street, thrown-away children are more likely to come from single-parent or broken homes. We categorized street children as those under 18 years old. Street children are often subject to abuse, neglect, exploitation. Street children are obviously not educated. Because of this, they don't have the same opportunities as other children.

Based on that awareness, the strategies to perform this project are:

- The strategy must come from the awareness of the condition of the street children, we have to enter through their daily life. They live in the street, unkempt and dirty. They work and earn money from the street by begging,

selling wares, becoming shoe shiners, performing music, etc. Their orientation is earning money so they can survive. We have to make program by this awareness.

- Based on that awareness, we will make interconnected workshops, the end of which is to make money. We will divided them into three groups. First group is sewing workshop for the girl. Second group is silk screen workshops for the boys. And the third group is other boys or girls that will promote and sell their product. The process are: the girls will produce t-shirts and the boys will make design and print it in the t-shirts. After the process of production, other street children will promote and sell that product. The location that close to the tourism resort will be very profitable.
- Most of the street children in Indonesia, especially in Yogyakarta making money by performing music in the crossroad. Some of them are very potential, being able to play musical instrument very well even though they do not get professional training. Sometime they make their own music instrument. We will facilitate and accompany them to become better music players so that they can earn more money.

## **2. Description of the project**

Street children are minors who live and survive on the streets. They often grow up in public landfills, train stations, or under the bridges of the major cities. They work as parking boys, shoe shiners, baggage loaders, goods vendors, beggars. Some older girls exchange sex for money. Others are involved in illegal work like drug dealing. The general public disliked them and mentioned them as criminals. Street children don't have the same opportunities as other children.

Research has demonstrated that no amount of intervention programming designed for street children can be successful unless the community is prepared to respect, protect and provide opportunities to street children. Based on this research, we want to give opportunity to the street children to improve their life with the awareness that they have various potentials to develop. They are not criminals, but they need opportunity to grow. We believe that they don't want to live in the street.

In this project, we will accompany street children in Prambanan, Bong Suwung and Code, Yogyakarta, Indonesia. For the street children in Prambanan, we will make interconnected

workshops that in the end will earn them some money. The workshop will be taken in their place. They rent small room for 3-4 people but they have public room that usually used for gathering. They allow us to use that room to make workshop.

We design the sewing workshop for the girls and silk screen workshop for the boys. The girls will sew t-shirt and the boys will print their design on the t-shirt. They will make their own design and product. Finally we will sell the product in the tourism resort in Jogjakarta. Actually, we do not only make workshop but also monitor the process marketing of the product. Furthermore, with this skills, they have more opportunities. They can find job in garment industry.

A lot of street children in Prambanan work as street performers. They can play music very well without formal education. They can make the music instrument by themselves. But no one respect to them because they are unkempt and dirty. We want to create a better group music so that they get more appreciation. We will prove to them that if they are clean and friendly, other people will respect and give more money. This program actually is a kind of character building program, but we want to facilitate better music instrument so that they will be more confident.

For the street children in Bong Suwung and in Code, we will accompany them to study in art and skills. Street children in Bong Suwung and Code are younger than street children in Prambanan. They go to school in the morning but after schools, they works in the street as a beggar, goods sellers, etc. They works because their parent can't provide all their needs. To do this project, we will invite volunteer from university to make a program. Accompanying street children in Bong Suwung and Core are not very risky because their range of age that around 6-12 year old. Project for street children in Prambanan have a greater risk due to older age.

Some risks that can be happened are:

- Street children have no endurance to work because they have no habit to work systematically. They want to get money quickly. This is a very tough challenge. We remember current workshop in which one by one left because of they did not like the process. To prevent this challenge, we will accompany the process more intensively. We will invite ex-street children to give support and testimony that what they do is good for their life.
- They will steal the asset and sell it. This is not because they are criminals, but because from their childhood they always struggle to survive. Since childhood

many of their wishes are not fulfilled like other children because of the poverty, they want a lot of things that they have never had. To prevent this risk, we will chose one coordinator, someone that is respected by all street children. Furthermore, we will use the funds very carefully. We are aware that the first condition they need is respect from other so that they can

### 3. Purpose and Aim

Street children are one of the most vulnerable groups of urban poor. They face difficulties while living in the streets, and they also develop their own ways to overcome such difficulties. That condition sometimes forces them to be creative. The main purpose of this project is give them opportunities to grow like other children. Targets of this project are street children in the age of 7-17 years old. In the Prambanan Project, we have targeted 30 street children (13-17 years old), 20 boys and 10 girls. Girls are less than boys because girls are more controlled by their families. If they escaped from their families, they will prefer any other place than the streets because they are aware that more subject to abuse than boys. We believe that they have the potential to be developed, what they need is opportunities. We also believe that they want to live better than in the street.

In the Bong Suwung Project, we have targeted 20 street children (7-10 years old) that will join our activity and in Code Community, we have targeted 30 street children (7-10 years old) to join our activities.

We are also aware that design project for the street children is not easy. Street children are children who always struggle themselves to live, many desires are not fulfilled. This condition makes them very oriented to make money to survive. This awareness makes us wise in behaving and using the funds. We want to accept them as a human being, appreciate all the struggles of their lives.

### 4. Planning

The project will be for one year, but, we hope that after this program they can produce and sell their own product by themselves.
